I take this opportunity to wish you all a very happy and prosperous Deepawali. As we complete this half – session of 2010- 11, I would like to thank all those of you who have supported us by following the rules of the school.

Please make note of the following points.

- 1) Kindly meet all the class teachers and subject teachers also, during today's parent – teacher meeting and go through your children's exam copies.
- 2) Kindly note – students of IX to XII have to report back on 8<sup>th</sup> November morning between 9:00 and 10:00 am. Report cards will be distributed then.  
Classes I to VIII boarders will report back on 9<sup>th</sup> November morning between 9:00 and 10:00 am and receive their Half – Yearly result. Those children who have elder brothers and sisters will report back to school on 8<sup>th</sup> November .
- 3) Fee for the third quarter must be paid in the front office on arrival, failing which the child will not be allowed to enter the hostel or attend classes and their half yearly report cards will be withheld.
- 4) You are requested to ensure that Senior students of Board classes put in atleast four hours of study during this Diwali break. They need to focus and work on their weak subjects.
- 5 i) The following are required from students on their return
  - a) Height of the child
  - b) Weight of the child
  - c) Blood groupAll should be certified by a general physician on his official letterhead.
- ii) 2 recent passport sized photographs
- 6) All students will bring their woollens and blankets when they return. Blankets will not be provided by the school. Casuals must be tagged and brought. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any untagged clothes.  
School blazers, sweaters and track suits will be provided to students when they return.
- 7) All students are required to bring any of the following to be given away as charity in any orphanage or old home.
  - rice, wheat, sugar
  - medical supplies like cotton, bandage
  - steel utensils - bowls, plates, glasses, spoons etc.
  - toiletries - soap, toothpaste etc.
- 8) There will be no outing in the month of November.

- 9) No child is permitted to bring back any eatables / dry fruits. The same will be confiscated if found.
- 10) Classes will commence for IX to XII on 9<sup>th</sup> morning 8:30 am and for I to VIII on 10<sup>th</sup> morning 8:30 am.
- Strict action will be taken against students who report **late**.
